The Department of Bioengineering at Stanford University, which is jointly supported by the Schools of Medicine and Engineering, seeks applicants for two new tenure-line faculty positions. The search is open at the level of Assistant Professor or untenured Associate Professor. Applicants are expected to have a doctoral degree in bioengineering, biomedical engineering, biophysics, or any related discipline. We encourage applications from physician-engineers.

We are searching for energetic and visionary individuals. We have a particular interest in candidates with expertise in biomedical devices, biomedical imaging, cell and molecular engineering, regenerative medicine, tissue engineering, and biomedical computation but are open to applications from candidates in any area related to bioengineering. We are open to applications from individuals working on problems ranging from analysis of molecular mechanisms to integrated systems. We are also interested in applications from individuals focused on areas ranging from fundamental biosciences to clinically motivated research. The new faculty members are expected to develop outstanding research and teaching programs.

Teaching responsibilities include the development of both undergraduate and graduate courses. The supervision of doctoral students and academic advising of students at all levels is expected. A strong commitment to graduate and undergraduate teaching and advising is essential.

Applicants should submit a letter containing a brief statement of interest, a curriculum vita, a statement of research and teaching interests, copies of two representative publications, and the names and addresses of five references. Candidates are requested to ask that references send letters directly to the search committee.
